EXT. Tardis as it spins we see windows in distress, panels being sucked away into space.





EXT. One whole side of Tardis now being sucked away, Tardis blurring as it spins. (Shot length 4 seconds)





INT. Tardis door with roundells all around it. As they pull away the door gets covered by enegy leaking through the cracks.





EXT. Lower ship docks with main vessel. Tardis is half embedded into larger ship. (Camera tracks L to R, looking up)





EXT. C/U of docking arm unlocking.... Cut to...





EXT. ...Wide. Smaller ship starts to move away.





EXT. Ship 'B' Blasts away from Camera.





EXT. We see ship B coming towards us and past the camera.




EXT. Ship A heads towards TERMINUS. Tardis still stuck on the side. The TERMINUS is massive, we realise this as ship A approaches.




EXT. Terminus begins to move away from us.



EXT. We see Ship B dock with Teminus in a much more impressive way (Zoom down was to ship docking arm/s)...




... There are several walkways docking.






EXT. TERMINUS, we see how big it is and see it's engines. (Here we see six smaller engines underneath)


INT. The massive interior of Terminus. (Camera cranes down) This shot needs to be done twice.


